Getting on Your Child's Level



Interact at their eye level

Show an interest in their interests

Join in their Play!


Commenting: What is it?



 Talking about <u>what your child</u> is doing or may be thinking or feeling

Talking about <u>what others</u> around your child may be doing, thinking or feeling

Commenting: How to do it




Comment around child's interests

Comment around daily routines

Comment around new experiences

Simplifying Language: Language Levels



Simplifying Language



- When you comment, use language that is, <u>at or just above</u> your child's language level
- Use the <u>Add One</u> Rule

Pausing



Why:

- Allows the child to process what was said
- Allows the child time to formulate an answer

How:

- Pause patiently and expectantly
- Pause in line with your child's attention span
